PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- Walnut Way is a discount travel program for City of Walnut residents.
- Walnut Way MAY be used for house to house trips and trips to parks within City Limits.
- Walnut Way MAY NOT be used as transportation to any school campus whatsoever
- Walnut Way is ideal for trips around town or anywhere within a five mile radius of the City limits. (See map on back of brochure).
- Walnut Way's hours of operation are 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Walnut Way's Calling Center hours of operation are 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- Members are permitted to use this service a total of 30 one-way trips per month.

WHAT IS THE COST?

- \$1 per ride within City limits
- \$1 per ride within 5 miles outside the City limits
- \$1 per ride to all Special Service Areas listed on brochure

To encourage shared rides, only one fare will be charged for groups of three or less who are traveling from the same pickup to the same destination.

WHEN AND WHERE TO SIGN UP?

Senior cards are for residents 55 years of age and older, or disabled residents under 55 years of age, who can provide medical verification regarding their disability. Proof of Residency can be verified by presenting a California Drivers License or California ID Card that includes your Walnut address.

If you do not have a photo ID with your Walnut address we will accept a current utility bill (gas, electric, or water only) with your name and Walnut address along with another photo ID with your name.

**Please note, having a Walnut mailing address does not necessarily mean that you live in the City of Walnut. Many bordering cities have Walnut addresses, but are not actually in the City's boundaries.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

When calling for pickup give the operator your:

- Phone number
- 2. Pick-up location and destination

The taxicab provider has a call when ready system.

Walnut Way is a curb-to-curb service and the taxi can neither wait nor go looking for riders.

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS NEEDED

Additional documentation will be needed to verify Senior or Disabled status. Please bring one of the following documents and your application to Walnut City Hall:

Senior Eligibility Documents:

- Birth Certificate Social Security/Medicare Card
- Driver's License
- DMV I.D. Card

Disability Eligibility Documents:

- VA Document of Disability
- Social Security Disability AwardAmericans w/ Disability ACT (ACDA) I.D. Card
- DMV Disability Card


