

### **BACKGROUND:**

Over the past few years, the Youth Advisory Commission has planned such projects as:

1. Anti-Bullying Day
2. STEM School Club Awareness Day
3. Mental Health Awareness
4. Student Shout Outs

The Youth Advisory Commission will review the status of its current projects, including the potential continuation of initiatives, considering ongoing challenges related to timely participation. Commissioners will assess whether any actions should proceed or if adjustments to the current plans are necessary.

### **ANALYSIS:**

The Commission will finalize a minimum of two achievable projects for the 24-25 year. City Staff will guide and assist with project selection in an advisory capacity.

Projects can be designed to address specific needs of youth in the community, address teen issues at Walnut High School or Suzanne Middle School, and/or contribute to the community via City programs/events. The Commission does not have a budget for such projects, however incidental supplies for posters and other promotional material will be provided by the city.
