

RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

Over the past few years, the Youth Advisory Commission has planned such projects as:

1. Anti-Bullying Day
2. STEM School Club Awareness Day
3. Mental Health Awareness
4. Student Shout Outs

The Youth Advisory Commission is able to modify any of the aforementioned projects or develop a new project. Projects may be lower scale and ongoing or one day events.

Projects can be designed to address specific needs of youth in the community, address teen issues at Walnut High School or Suzanne Middle School, and/or contribute to the community via City programs/events. The Commission does not have a budget for such projects, however incidental supplies for posters and other promotional material will be provided by the City.

ANALYSIS:

The Commission's sub-committee provided an update on their meeting Senior Center staff regarding the Senior Center Prom Dinner and Dance. Following their discussion, the full Commission agreed to divide the following responsibilities; Centerpieces, Entertainment, Photobooth/"Paparazzi", Senior Court, Performance and Promotion. Coordinator Justine Romano has connected the Commissioners and Senior Center staff via email, and the Commission will provide an update on outreach and progress.

In addition, the Commission discussed an idea to organize a holiday gift drive and was tasked with reaching out to foster/adoption services to explore feasibility. The Commission is expected to provide an update on any contacts made, noting potential concerns regarding timing and available opportunity.
